## RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All vegetables, plants and flowers entered must be grown by the entrant.
2. More than one entrant may exhibit from the same garden.
3. One exhibit per person per class.
4. No exhibits may be entered from previous years.
5. All exhibits must be staged by 10am and will not be accepted past this time.
6. The judging will commence at 10am from which time no entrance will be permitted to the village hall.
7. Exhibits must not be removed before the presentation of the Cups and certificates at 4pm.
8. Prize money not collected by 4pm will be deemed a donation to the club.
9. All exhibits stating the use of a bikini vase must use the exhibition vases provided by the gardening club flower show committee / stewards.
10. The Committee will not accept responsibility for the loss or damage to any exhibit.
11. In the event of only one entry in a class a prize may only be awarded at the discretion of the judge.
12. Exhibitors can let another person or steward act on their behalf if they are unable to stage their exhibits on the morning of the show.
13. Children must state their age on the entry form.
14. No artificial flowers allowed unless stated.
15. All entry forms must be delivered **no later than 8pm on THURSDAY**
